Their gritty, groove driven guitar work and attitude scream through the speakers as you listen to any track off of the band's debut album, "Land of Lincoln," (Release Date: September 5th, 2008) which was recorded and produced in Chicago by former Hollywood Records producer John L. Sullivan.

Hailing from the infamous South Side of Chicago, comes five guys proud to represent the tough, blue collar streets of Chicago and all that they represent. Taking a stand for the common man, telling it like it is - like it or not - this is what the music of "Low of the Low" is all about. This isn't just music they make; it's a way of life!
